

Rifle Range Rules

1. Proper gun safety shall be observed always and includes mandatory use of adequate hearing and eye protection by all present.
2. Members must post the RED flag on the flag box while using the rifle range.
3. Members MUST sign in the log book upon arrival and guest MUST read and sign the release agreement.
4. The red lights must be turned on before entering the range beyond the shooting bench area to alert others that people are on the range. In the event of a power outage use the safety flags in lieu of the red lights.
5. All firearms are to be unloaded with actions open AND the firearm laid down or cased while the red lights are on. No handling of firearms in any manner while people are down range including sight adjustments. Keep hands off firearms.
6. Only approved targets posted on the center backing of the target frames are permitted (see authorized target list posted at the range). Targets of any other kind are prohibited (balloons, steel gongs, clay targets etc.) and targets are not to be placed in such a manner that shots impact the railings and posts of the target frames.
7. All shooting must be from the shooting benches. Absolutely no shooting outside this area.
8. Firearms using centerfire cartridges .50 BMG caliber or larger are prohibited.
9. Fully automatic firearms are prohibited.
10. Rapid fire from any firearm is limited to 8 rounds at a time.
11. Tracers or any ammunition considered incendiary or explosive are prohibited.
12. Shooting hours are from 8:00am to 9:00pm only.
13. Each member is permitted 1 (one) guest. The member and guest must share a single bench when other members are waiting to shoot.
14. When members are waiting for an available bench, members actively shooting are limited to a 30-minute session and must then yield the station to waiting members.
15. Membership cards must be displayed when using the range.
16. Shotguns may be patterned on the range. Use the designated movable target rack.
17. No vehicles are allowed on the range
18. No unattended children under 18 are allowed in the vicinity of the range.
19. Do NOT dispose of live or defective ammunition in the trash can. Use the defective ammo boxes provided.
20. Before leaving the range, members MUST:
 - a. Remove used targets from the backstops and dispose of properly
 - b. Dispose of any trash
 - c. Pick up discharged brass and place in containers provided
 - d. Turn off lights if applicable
 - e. Record departure time in the log book
21. If you are leaving an unoccupied rifle and pistol range, un-post the RED flag as you exit the grounds.
